Rules of Glenullin GAC Open Feis

1. Glenullin GAC Feis is run under the rules of An Comhdhail Muinteoiri Na Rinci Gaelacha
2. Solo costumes may not be worn in any competition up to and including under 9
3. Facial Make-up may not be worn in any competition up to and including under 12
4. Age as determined on January 1st 2023
5. No changing of costumes will be permitted in the hall.
6. Dancers should be properly dressed at all times.
7. No photography or use of videos or camera phones may be used during a competition.
8. Photographs may be taken during presentation of prizes.
9. Competitions may be added or withdrawn, depending on time.
10. Under 18 & Over 18 will be split if there is a minimum of 5 dancers in both age groups.
11. The adjudicators' decision in all circumstances will be final.
12. Cups to be returned on day of feis in time for the respective age group.
13. Dancers must wear their number position centre front, clearly visible for adj.
14. To be eligible to compete in a Championship or Perpetual Trophy Comp, competitors must have competed

in at least one OPEN solo comp, excluding treble reel and both solos in Championship.

Trophies/Cups for 1st places in solo comps & to 1st - 5th in C'ships/Confined and Cup Competitions

Podiums for 1st - 5th places in all Championships/ Cup Competitions

Sashes for 1st - 5th places in Open Championships

Sashes for 1st place in Confined Reel/ Cup Comps

Beg Comp A :-Open to those dancers who are dancing at feiseanna for their 1st year and/or have not previously won a 1st place in a BEG A competition. Class costumes or skirt/blouse must be worn in all beginner competitions.
