RULES

(Run Under The Rules of An Comhdháil na Múinteoirí le Rincí Gaelacha)

- 1 Ages will be taken as of the 1st January 2023 and proof of date of birth will be required if challenged.
 - 2 The decision of the adjudicator is final. An objection may be lodged by a teacher before the result is announced, with a fee of £15.00.
 - 3 Beginners A – Confined to competitors who have never won 1st place in that particular dance in any age group
 - 4 Beginners B – Confined to competitors who have never won 1st place in that particular dance in any age group
 - 5 Pre-Open – Confined to competitors who have never won 1st place in that particular age group. Age the competition to be under is specified. Competitors may only compete out of age if a dance is not catered for on the syllabus
 - 6 Open – Open to all competitors. Competitors may not dance out of their age group unless a dance is not catered for in their age group. From U9 upwards dancers must compete in at least one open solo competition (excluding the Treble Reel) to be eligible to compete in the
 - 7 open solo championships.
 - 8 Dancers must be in full costume including shoes for the presentation of prizes.
Children up to and including the age of 12 are prohibited from wearing facial make-up and all dancers are prohibited from wearing glitter on
 - 9 their face.
"No videos or flash photography during performances. Any form of unauthorised photography which captures a dancer's image whilst taking part in competition is expressly forbidden. This covers photography by means of mobile phone, video camera and cine recorder with or without flash facility." This includes all "Parade of Champions"
 - 10
 - 11 No smoking including e-cigarettes or alcohol permitted anywhere within the school grounds.
 - 12 Mobile phones must be switched off or on silent in competition halls
Competitors in Beginners A, B and figure must wear class costumes or skirt and blouse etc. Those wearing solo costumes will not be allowed to
 - 13 compete and their entry fee will not be refunded
 - 14 Any dancer found to be using artificial carriage aids which prevent full lateral and vertical movement of arms will be disqualified.
- Beginner A Soft Dance Trophy– Dancers must have performed in any soft dance in Beginners A . (Reel, Light Jig, Single Jig or Slip Jig
- 15 competition). Competitors must have competed in the solo dance in Beginners A to perform it in the trophy dance.
- Beginner B Trophy– Dancers must have performed in any soft dance in Beginners A or B . (Reel, Light Jig, Single Jig, Slip Jig or heavyjig
- 16 competition). Competitors must have competed in the solo dance in Beginners A or B to perform it in the trophy dance.
- Pre Open Trophy – Dancers must have danced in one of the Pre Open competitions in their own age group. Dancers must be in Pre Open for the dance they perform in the trophy dance. (Treble reel may not be danced in the trophy competition). Dancers may only compete in one PO
- 17 trophy.
- ***Mary Steen Memorial Cups – are confined to dancers whose teachers are registered with the London & Home Counties and Southern
- 18 England Region branches
- ****Outside London Trophies – Confined to dancers registered outside of the London & Home Counties and Southern England Region
- 19 Branches
- Walkers - Dancers who compete in this competition may not participate in any competition throughout the event. Dancers can be supported
- 20 while performing their dance.
