## Feis Rules / Notes

- Newry City Championships is registered with An Chomhdháil Muinteóirí na Rincí Gaelacha.
- Age as on 1st January 2026
- Solo Costumes may not be worn in Beginners competitions or by competitors up to and including under 9.
- No changing of costumes is permitted in the hall and dancers must always be dressed appropriately.
- Make up is not allowed on children up to and including under 12 – glitter is prohibited for all ages.
- Beginner steps must be danced in beginner grades.
- A, B and Preopen Cups - Competitors must have competed in at least one dance in that section and must be the cup grade for the dance performed.
- Open Cup Under 6 & 7 will be judged by one adjudicator.
- Open Championships Under 8 & 9 will be one adjudicator championships.
- Open Championships Under 10 upwards will be three adjudicator championships.
- To be eligible to compete in Open championship from U10+ the dancer MUST have danced the Set Dance Competition\*\*
- Competitors must dance in their own age group unless a dance is not catered for, in which case, they may dance up one age group only.
- Competitors must be in full costume for the presentation of prizes.
- Perpetual trophies must be returned in excellent condition annually in advance of the following year's feis. An Chomhdháil rules will apply.
- No photography or videography of any kind may be used during a competition. Photographs may be taken during the presentation of prizes.
- The Adjudicators decision is final in all matters.
- All fees are non-refundable.
- Objections with the relevant fee of £10 must be lodged within 30 mins of results.
- The decision of the committee is final on all matters appertaining to the running of the feis.
- All litter must be placed in the rubbish bins provided.

- At the end of the Camlough Road, at the roundabout, take the second exit onto Clanrye Avenue
- Take the first left onto Cecil Street and the Newry Leisure Centre is straight ahead.

### Directions from South:

- From the A1, take the exit for Newry and A25 (Camlough)
- At the roundabout, take the fourth exit onto Camlough Road towards Newry
- At the end of the Camlough Road, at the roundabout, take the second exit onto Clanrye Avenue
- Take the first left onto Cecil Street and the Newry Leisure Centre is straight ahead
