Costume Changing

The INEC has numerous changing facilities available for dancers to change. These facilities MUST be used for costume changes. Dancers ARE NOT permitted to change in any public area. Dancers MUST be properly attired at all times. Dancers should refrain from inappropriate clothing such as undergarments that are worn under costumes. We appreciate your understanding and co-operation in maintaining a suitable environment for all.

Photography

The recording of dancing is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN** apart from recording by our partners, Feis TV. Our security team will be looking out for anyone using cameras/phones to record dancers. Should anyone be found in breach of this rule, they will be escorted from the venue. Should any footage appear on social media, an investigation will take place and action may be taken. Parents, please make your children aware of this important rule.

Proof of Age

All dancers must have their passport or birth certificate with them for the duration of their competition. In accordance with Rule 14 on the World Championships syllabus, random date of birth checks will be carried out.



Rules & Regulations

- 1. Strict order must be maintained in the Competition Halls while competitors are performing. Standing in the vicinity of the aisles or exits is not permitted.
- 2. Competitors must dance in strict numerical order and must be present in the competition hall 30 minutes prior to the competition start time.
- 3. Numbers must be worn in the centre of costumes by all competitors. Numbers must NOT be laminated.
- 4. Emblems or designs on costumes which indicate the former achievements of a competitor are forbidden e.g. 'globes'. All names and initials are strictly prohibited on solo costumes.
- 5. Full dance costume (including shoes) must be worn by all competitors receiving awards on stage.
- 6. The coaching of pupils during their performances either from competition halls or side stage is not permitted.
- 7. No smoking of any form in competition halls.
- 8. Food or drink must not be consumed in competition halls.
- 9. Alcohol is strictly prohibited in competition halls.
- 10.Instructions of security staff, officials and stewards must be complied with at all times.
- 11.An Chomhdháil and the INEC, Killarney, are not responsible for property **LOST OR STOLEN** during the Championships.
- 12. Parents and Teachers are responsible for ensuring that competitors and children in their charge behave in an appropriate manner.





Rules & Regulations

- 13. Changing of costumes is not permitted in the competition halls. Please use designated changing rooms which are clearly signed.
- 14.Dancers must be appropriately attired in any public area of the premises. Dancers should refrain from inappropriate clothing such as undergarments that are worn under costumes. We appreciate your understanding and co-operation in maintaining a suitable environment for all.
- 15.Dancers must start their performance on one of the markers on stage.
- 16.An Chomhdháil is General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) compliant. Please be mindful of this when taking photographs, posting on social media and live streaming.
- 17. The use of any unauthorised photography which captures a dancer's image while taking part in competition is forbidden. This covers photography by means of mobile phone, standard camera and video camera, cine recorder with or without flash facility. Action shots by authorised official photographers, Eclipse Photography, are permitted.
- 18.An Chomhdháil, the INEC, Killarney, Gleneagle Hotel and Brehon Hotel reserve the right of admission. Anyone found causing damage to any of the above-mentioned properties or engaging in **unauthorised vending** will be asked to leave the premises and re-entry will be denied.
